

Battery Declaration for Road and Air transport

There are numerous types of batteries now ranging from AAA Alkaline to Lithium Metal Batteries. Different batteries have different lodgment and consigning requirements including labels used, wording on consignment note and packaging type. Some batteries are forbidden to be lodged as airfreight.

To best help us assist you with your battery movement we require as much information as possible to ensure we are accurately advising you and correctly declaring the item for the mode of transport chosen.
